PER COURT :

1. Heard the respective counsels.
2. The learned counsel for the applicant would submit that 29 days delay caused in filing the Criminal Revision Application. The delay is not deliberate. The reason is beyond the control of the applicant. Hence, the delay may be condoned.
3. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 strongly opposed the application. He would submit that the reasons mentioned in the application are not genuine.
