PER COURT :-

1. The record indicates, the petitioners have lodged the complaint/so called FIR with the concerned Police Station. The PSO appears to have not responded thereto.
2. The Police Station Officer shall inform the petitioners his response thereto within a period of two weeks. Needless to mention, if the concerned Officer refuses to register FIR, the petitioners have their remedy under section 156(3) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
