PER COURT :

1. The learned counsel – Mr B.M. Dhanure waives service for respondent Nos.1 and 2.
2. The learned A.G.P. waives service of notice for respondent No.3.
3. Heard rival submissions.
4. The applicants are seeking condonation of delay of 620 days, which appears to be caused due to their poor financial condition.

5. The learned counsel for the respondent Nos.1 and 2 and learned A.G.P. strongly opposed the application on the ground that, delay is not properly explained.

6. However, considering the statutory right of the applicants and for the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed and the delay of 620 days stands condoned, subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the period of aforesaid delay.
