1. Heard.
2. The respective applicants are seeking withdrawal of their

amounts of compensation, which have been deposited by the acquiring body alongwith the interest accrued thereon.

3. This Court vide order dated 4th January, 2023 in other connected matters has permitted the applicants therein to withdraw 75% of the deposited amounts.

4. In view of the same, present applicants are permitted to withdraw 75% of the compensation amounts alongwith the proportionate interest accrued thereon till date i.e. 50% on usual undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this court and remaining 25% on furnishing solvent surety / security.

5. The remaining amounts be invested in F.D.R. in any Nationalized Bank on yearly renewal basis till disposal of these appeals.

6. The civil applications are accordingly disposed of.
