ORDER :

1. By this application filed under section 439(2) of Cr.P.C., applicant/informant seeks cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondents No. 2 to 7 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amalner in Crime No. 22/2019, registered with Amalner Police Station, under section 420 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard the learned advocate for the applicant, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent-State and learned advocate for respondents No. 2 to 7. Perused the documents placed on record.
