2. The petitioner is seeking direction to respondent No.2 to renew the petitioner's passport. It is informed that there are some criminal cases registered against the petitioner. The prayer in this petition is only regarding renewal of the passport. He is not asking for permission to go abroad.

3. In view of the same, if there is no any other hurdle for respondent No.2, he is directed to renew the petitioner's passport within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Needless to mention, if the petitioner proposes to go abroad, the petitioner will necessarily have to seek permission of the

court concerned which is seized of the criminal case/s in which the petitioner is involved.

5. With the above observations and directions, the writ petition stands disposed of.
