PER COURT :

1. The learned advocate for respondent no. 4 at the outset points out that a remedy is available under Section 9 of the Maharashtra Money Lending (Regulation) Act, 2014. He submits that the impugned order is passed on 08.05.2018, whereas; the present petition is filed on 26.11.2021. There is delay in filing the petition.

2. In view of aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the appropriate forum.

3. Writ Petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

4. Needless to state that the time consumed in prosecuting the instant petition shall be taken into consideration by the authority while considering the prayer for condonation of delay i.e. from the date of filing of the petition till passing of the order.
