PER COURT :-

1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant, learned APP for the respondent-State and learned counsel for respondent No.2.

2. The trial has been opened. The statement of the victim appears serious against the applicant. Let the trial Court decide the evidential value of the C.A. report, for the reason that the pathological vaginal examination report goes against the accused. If the copy of this report has not been supplied to him, the prosecution to supply him a copy of the same. Considering the gravity of the offence, more particularly, the age of the victim who was only eight (8) years and four (4)

months at the time of the incident as well as the applicant is their relative, it would not be safe to release him on bail.

3. Hence, the application stands dismissed.

4. The observations recorded in this order are restricted to the present bail application only.
