PER COURT :

1. The learned Advocate representing Respondent No.3 has appeared on Advocate's notice. There are 3 Petitioners. He submits that their deposits are small figures in between Rs.75,000/- to Rs. 85,000/- approximately, including the interest. Within 2 (two) weeks, their money would be returned to them. He tenders a copy of the chart dated 26.10.2023 indicating the remaining customers which are 1567 and the total balance amount of Rs.1,44,00,000/- including the interest. He submits that though the dues of these Petitioners would be paid within 2 weeks, the rest of the customers would be paid their

deposits with interest, within one year. The said chart is taken on record and marked as 'X' for identification.

2. The learned Advocate for the Petitioners submits on instructions that the Petitioners are satisfied.

3. In view of the above, **this Petition is disposed off.**
