Per Court:

. The mediation is successful. The terms of settlement have been placed on record. The same is taken on record and marked as 'X' for identification. The parties have moved for dissolution of marriage in terms of Section 13(1)(B) of the Hindu Marriage Act. The respondent/ wife has received ornaments today itself and acknowledgment receipt

executed in that regard is placed on record. The said receipt is taken on record and marked as 'Y' for identification. A *lumpsum* amount is agreed to be paid towards maintenance by the time the decree of dissolution of marriage would be passed. It is one of the terms that the amount to be paid would be deposited with the Family Court.

2 In view of the above and since the respondent/wife gives express consent to allow the petition, the criminal writ petition is allowed in terms of prayer clauses (B) and (B.1).
