the Deputy Director of Revenue Intelligence, Mumbai dated 16.02.2023 informing that a decision is taken by the competent authority to de-freeze the account and fixed deposit mentioned in the letter.

5. In view of the same, this Court finds that, the present application also can be allowed in terms of prayer clause (B).
