05.06.2023. Learned AGPs waive service for all the respondents in respective applications.

3. Heard rival submissions.

4. The respective applicants are seeking condonation of delay periods mentioned in these applications, which appears to be caused due to their poor financial condition.

5. The learned AGPs strongly opposed the applications on the ground that no reasonable cause is mentioned for condoning the delay periods.

6. However, considering the statutory right of the applicants and for the reasons stated in the applications, the applications are allowed and the delay periods mentioned therein stand condoned subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the aforesaid delay periods.

7. The appeals be placed for admission after removal of office objections, if any.
