ORDER:-

1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The respective applicants are seeking condonation of delay of 2934 days in these applications, which appear to be caused due to their poor financial condition.
3. The learned AGP strongly opposed the applications on the ground that no reasonable cause is mentioned for condoning the delay periods.
4. Considering the statutory right of the applicants and for the reasons stated in the applications, the applications are

allowed and the delay of 2934 days in these applications stands condoned subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the period of aforesaid delay.

5. The appeals be placed for admission after removal of office objections, if any.

6. The applications are accordingly disposed of.
