Although, no case is made out for granting any extension, based on Mr Parrikar's assurance which assurance Mr Parrikar gives based on the instructions from the Applicant who is present in the Court, the time limits specified in the order dated 06.10.2023 for instituting an appeal and making a pre-deposit are extended by further two weeks from today.
