

of the Petitioner Trust. This implies that the interest of the Applicant is adverse to that of the Petitioner.

5. In the circumstances, it is not necessary to implead the Applicant as party to this proceeding to test the legality, propriety and correctness of the order passed by the Competent Authority. The Applicant is, however, at liberty to advance the submissions in opposition to the Petition.

6. The Application stands disposed.

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7. Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner.

8. Issue Notice to the Respondents, returnable on 8 June 2023.

9. The learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent Nos.1, 2 and 4.

10. In addition to notice through Court, the Petitioner is at liberty to serve Respondent No.3 by private service and file an Affidavit of Service.
