Learned counsel for the Petitioners submitted that now there is change in circumstances as the Respondent No.1 has remarried and therefore the prayers mentioned in her complaint before the Magistrate are no longer surviving. As far as the rent and maintenance part is concerned, he submitted that liberty may be granted to the Petitioners to point out this fact to the learned Magistrate. He seeks withdrawal of this Petition with such liberty.

2. Considering these submissions, the Petition is allowed to be withdrawn. The Petitioners are at liberty to make an appropriate application in accordance with law in the changed circumstances as submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners.
3. If such application is made, it shall be decided in accordance with law.
4. With these observations and liberty the Petition is allowed to be withdrawn and is disposed of as such.
