1. Heard. Petition can be disposed of in view of the consensus which has been arrived at between the learned counsel for the parties that the document i.e. partition deed can be exhibited and all objections as to whether the same is memorandum of partition and as to whether the same is required to be compulsory registered can be decided at the time of final arguments.

2. In view of the consensus which has been arrived between the parties, this Court has not gone into the merits of the matter. Writ petition stands disposed of in terms of the agreement arrived at by

learned counsel for the parties that the document can be exhibited with all the objections to be considered at the time of final arguments.

3. In view of the above, the impugned order dated 27th October, 2017 is hereby quashed and set aside.
