The Special Court under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 [“POCSO Act”] has acquitted the Respondent No.2 for the offences punishable under Sections 354-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 [“IPC”] and Sections 7 and 8 of the POCSO Act. This is an Appeal filed by the First-Informant.
