INTERIM APPLICATION NO.1953 OF 2021:-

1. The Applicant-Insurance Company has sought restoration of the appeal, which was dismissed for non-removal of office objections within the stipulated time. Learned counsel for the Applicant states that the objections will be removed within two weeks.
