1. The learned counsel appearing for the parties would jointly submit that the parties have amicably resolved the disputes. The consent terms are tendered. The same are taken on record and marked 'X' for identification.

Terms are also signed by the Secretary and Treasurer of the Petitioner-Society.

Ms. Kapadia, learned counsel appearing for the Respondent would submit that two cheques of Rs.1,00,000/- and Rs.1,50,000/- mentioned in para-2 of the Consent Terms have been drawn by the Society in a wrong name. Ms. Kapadia, has accordingly returned the cheques mentioned in para-2 to Mr. Belage, the learned counsel for the Petitioner. Mr. Belage submits that he shall handover the cheques for Rs.1,00,000/- and Rs.1,50,000/- in the correct name of the Respondent by tomorrow i.e. 20 October 2023. The statement is accepted as an Undertaking to the Court. In view of the Consent Terms filed, the Writ Petition is **disposed of**.
