(b) The applicant shall furnish the details of his residential address and phone number to the investigating officer.

(c) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the facts to Court or any Police Officer and should not tamper with evidence.
