. It is an admitted fact on record that, in pursuance of Order dated 17.03.2023, the Investigation of present crime was transferred to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Zone -1, Thane.

2. The Deputy Commissioner of Police, Zone -1, Thane is personally present in the Court. He through learned A.P.P. submitted that, the investigation of the present crime is completed and the investigating agency would submit a final report as contemplated under Section 173(2) of Cr.P.C. before the competent Court having jurisdiction, within a period of two weeks from today.

That, the investigating agency is conducting a separate inquiry for the same and if necessary will take appropriate steps as contemplated under the provisions of law against the Petitioner and all other concerned.
