4. Upon disputes arising between the parties, the petitioner invoked the arbitration clause by notice dated 25/9/2017, but there was no response from the respondents, necessitating filing of the present petition.

5. Upon the respondents being served, they have appeared through counsel. A name from the panel of arbitrators maintained by the Ministry of Defence is suggested, to which the petitioner has no objection. Therefore, by consent of the parties, Shri. Prakash Makhijani, Retired Joint Director General (Civil) from the Military Engineering Service is appointed as a sole arbitrator for resolution of disputes between the parties.
