1. Heard learned counsel for the Applicant.
2. The learned counsel for the Applicant submits that Registrar Judicial-(II) by order dated 29 September, 2015, directed the applicant to supply the copies within two weeks, but the said copies were not supplied within stipulated time. Hence, appeal is dismissed.
