1. Learned counsel for the Applicant on instructions seeks withdrawal of the Civil Revision Application.

Learned counsel for the Respondents submits that vide order dated 16th February, 2009, the Applicant was directed to deposit the outstanding amount of Rs. 3,50,000/- which has been deposited by the Applicant. According to him, the Respondent is entitled to withdraw the amount of Rs. 3,50,000/- deposited by the Applicant.
