1. Appellant is the the original complainant in C.R No.563 of 2018 registered with Bharti Vidyapeeth Police Station, Pune for offences under Sections 352, 504, 506 of IPC and u/s.3(1)(r)(s) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

2. Appellant is aggrieved by order dated 5th December 2018 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Pune granting anticipatory bail to the respondent nos.1 to 4.
