1 Mr.Vanarse states that Court may direct Respondent No.1 to dispose the Appeal within such time, as the Court may consider it appropriate, but in any case, atleast time till 31st May 2023, be granted.

2 Mr.Vanarse states that the assembly session has also started on 27th February 2023 and he expects it to go on for four weeks.

3 Accordingly, Respondent No.1 is directed to dispose the Appeal filed by Petitioner not later than 31st May 2023.

4 Before disposing the Appeal, a personal hearing shall be granted and the notice of personal hearing shall be communicated at

Petitioner and all other parties to the appeal atleast 7 working days in advance. After the personal hearing should Petitioner and all other parties to the appeal wish to submit written submissions recording what transcribed during the hearing, the same to be filed within three working days after the personal hearing.

5 The order to be passed will be a reasoned order dealing with every submissions of Petitioner and all other parties to the appeal.

6 Petition disposed.

7 Until the disposal of the Appeal, Respondent No.2/3 shall not take any coercive steps.

8 We clarify that we have not made any observation on the merits of the matter. All rights and contentions of the parties are kept open.
