Reply affidavit is filed on behalf of Respondent No.9 –
the State Co-operative Election Authority in which in paragraph 9
the Respondent No.9 has stated as under :-

*“9. With reference to paragraphs 1 of the said
Petition, the Petitioner has given details about the order.
I say that the Respondent No.8 has not deposited the
amount of election expenses, therefore the process could*

not started. Now the society has deposited the election expenses therefore the process can be started after government extension is over i.e. after 30/09/2023 as the case may be, if there is no other legal impediment.”
