1. Heard Mr. Kapse, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner, Mr. Sawant, learned AGP for the Respondent Nos.1 to 3-State and Mr. Talkute, learned counsel appearing for Respondent Nos.4[a] to 4[c] and 5A[a] to 5A[d].
