1. Applicants, i.e. husband, father-in-law, mother-in-law and sister-in-law of Respondent No.1, have filed present Application for quashing of C.C. No. PW/5701493/2019 pending on the file of learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 57th Court, Kurla, Mumbai arising out of C.R. No. 136 of 2018 registered with Shivaji Nagar Police Station, Mumbai, under Section 498A, 406, 323, 504, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, with the consent of Respondent No.1.

2. Mr. Jain, learned Advocate for Applicants submitted that, Applicants and Respondent No.1 have settled the matter amicably and have executed Consent Terms dated 23rd June, 2023. Respondent No.1 is personally present in the Court and through her Advocate admits execution of Consent Terms dated 23rd June, 2023 and her “no objection” for quashing the crime in question.
