1. Learned Counsel for the petitioners in Writ Petition No.1515 of 2020 states that the petitioners have made a complaint to various authorities seeking enquiry and for taking action against the erring officers. He submits that the concerned officers had

assaulted the petitioner nos.3 to 7 by kicks blows. He submits that the police have not taken any cognizance of the said complaint nor did they call the petitioners pursuant to the said complaint / representations made by the petitioners.
