1. By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing and setting aside of the circular bearing No. DGP/15/68/A6/THANE RURAL/614/2001 dated 22nd September, 2001 annexed at Exhibit A-Exhibit A/1 issued by the respondent no. 2 i.e. Director General of Police, State of Maharashtra.

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2. The grievance of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the said circular is unconstitutional and contrary to law and that no such direction can be passed by any authority “not to take any actions on the Applications/Complaints of the Petitioner and or his Committee.”
