1. The Petition is filed challenging the order dated 13/02/2023 passed by the District Judge-4, Kolhapur, in Misc. Civil Appeal No.12 of 2023 arising out of order dated 22/12/2022 passed by learned 5th Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, Kolhapur, passed below Ex.5 and Ex.107 in Special Civil Suit No.161 of 2019. Learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for contesting Respondent No.3 very fairly state that instead of inviting orders on merits, the Petition can be disposed of, if directions are issued to the Trial Court for

deciding the suit within a period of six months from today and in the meantime both the parties shall maintain status-quo.

2. The submission of both the learned counsel is fair. Therefore, the Writ Petition is disposed of. The Trial Court is requested to complete the trial as far as possible within a period of six months from today. In the meantime, as submitted by learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for contesting Respondent No.3, there shall be status-quo.
