The applicant came to be arrested in Crime No.287 of 2016 registered at Khadki Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 324, 452, 323, 504, 143, 144, 147, 148, 149 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 3(1)(r)(s) and 3(z), (5) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 , Section 4(25) of Arms Act and 37(1) read with 135 of Bombay Police Act.

4. Considering the fact that offences punishable under the provisions of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 are invoked against the applicants, the

application cannot be entertained as the applicant has to file an appeal against the rejection of his bail application by the Special Court.
