1. Learned Counsel for the Appellant, under instructions, seeks leave to withdraw both the appeals.
2. Leave granted. Appeals are dismissed as withdrawn.
3. Statutory deposit be transferred to MACT, Mangaon, Raigad.
4. Court fee, as permissible under the rules, be refunded..
5. It is stated that the claimants in both the claim petitions have

withdrawn 50% of the compensation. The Claimant No.1 in respective petitions, being the widow, be paid 20% of the compensation with proportionate interest accrued thereon, and the parent/parents of the deceased be paid 10% of the compensation with proportionate interest accrued thereon. Since the claimant nos.2 and 3 in respective claim petitions are minors, 10% each compensation with proportionate interest accrued thereon be invested in their respective names under Fixed Deposit in any nationalized bank, for a period of three years.
