1. By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of the F.I.R, registered vide C.R. No.05 of 2022, with the Economic Offence Wing, Nashik, for the alleged offences punishable under sections 406, 409, 420, 464, 465, 467, 471, 120-B r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
