The Petitioner has challenged the election process held on 3 April 2022 in respect of the Shubh Chintak Heights, Co-operative Housing Society in which the Petitioner is stated to be a member. It is more than settled that the challenge to the election process ordinarily will not be examined in the writ jurisdiction when there is an appropriate remedy under the governing statute is available where all questions including the questions of fact can be decided.

2. In the light thereof, we dispose of the Writ Petition keeping all contentions open.
