1. Mr. Todi, applicant appearing in person through video conferencing, submits that inadvertently, in the order dated 16th October 2023, it is recorded that the matter to stand over to 30th November 2023 instead of 30th October 2023.

2. Ms. Kudtarkar, learned counsel for respondent no. 1 does not dispute the aforesaid. Accordingly, in the order dated 16th October 2023, para 4 now shall be read as 30th October 2023 instead of 30th November 2023. The said order to be corrected accordingly.
