1. By this application, the applicant-insurer prays for staying effect, execution and implementation of the judgment and award passed by the Commissioner for Employees Compensation Eleventh Labour Court, Mumbai on 5th August, 2022 in Application (ECA) No.122/B-23/2019.

2. Ms. Shalini Shankar, learned Counsel for the applicant submits that entire amount under Award along with accrued interest has already been deposited before the Court below.

3. Ms. Shalini Shankar submits that the applicant has a good case on merits and, therefore, prays for staying the effect and
