1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. By this petition, the Petitioner seeks direction to the Respondent Nos.1 to 6 to register the FIR as against the Respondent No.7 for committing offences punishable under Sections 406, 417, 418 and 426 read with Section 120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
3. Learned APP states that pursuant to the complaint dated 22nd November, 2021, addressed by the Petitioner to the Police

Inspector, Police Station, Pimpri Chinchwad, Pune, the police have conducted a preliminary inquiry and accordingly, have come to the conclusion that the dispute is civil in nature. She submits, on instructions, that the said decision has been communicated to the petitioner *vide* letter dated 15th June, 2022.
