1. Learned A.G.P, on instructions, states that the two revision applications i.e. RTS/3423/951/Case No.15/J-5 and RTS/3423/952/Case No.14/J-5 are pending before the Hon'ble Minister (for Revenue) and the next date of the hearing is kept on 08/05/2023.
