1. Learned A.P.P. submitted that, during the pendency of this appeal, charge sheet has been filed against the appellant and other co-accused on 21.04.2023. The co-accused Alok Kumar Satish Upadhyay, who had preferred Criminal Appeal No.417 of 2023 had withdrawn his appeal and sought liberty to prefer application for bail before the trial Court.
