1. FIR is registered under sections 323, 324, 341, 354, 427, 504, 506 read with 34 of IPC. The maximum sentence is not more than seven years as such the provisions of section 41-A of the Code of Criminal Procedure will come into play. So also the observations of the Apex Court in case of *Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar and Anr.*¹, will not come in force if such notice is not given.
