1. Applicants i.e. husband and mother-in-law of Respondent No.2 have filed present Application under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for quashing of C.R. No. 25 of 2023, dated 9th January, 2023, registered with Park Site Police Station, Mumbai under Sections 498A, 323, 406, 504, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, by consent of Respondent No.2.

2. Learned Advocate appearing for Respondent No.2 tendered across the bar Affidavit of Respondent No.2 dated 28th April, 2023 duly affirmed before a Notary Public. Her signature has been identified by Advocate Mr. Mandar G. Bagkar.
