1. Learned Counsel for the applicant, seeks leave to withdraw this application with liberty to file a fresh application seeking the applicant's enlargement on bail, after one year.

It appears that this Court vide order dated 12th July 2023 passed in Criminal Bail Application No.3981 of 2021, preferred by the co-accused – Majorsing Ashokkumar Chouhan @Dhakkan has rejected the bail application of the said accused and has expedited the trial and directed that the trial conclude within a period of one year from the
