1. After arguing the Application for some time, learned counsel appearing for the Applicants on instructions states that the Applicants may be allowed to withdraw the present Application by granting time for a period of three weeks to surrender. Learned APP on instructions states that time of three weeks may be granted to the Applicants to surrender.

2. Hence following order is passed :

(i) The Application is dismissed as withdrawn.

(ii) The Applicant shall surrender before the concerned Investigating Officer of the concerned Police Station on or before 7th June 2023.
