Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and tenders the consent terms which is executed by the Petitioner and the Respondent No.2, Respondent Nos.3A to 3C. Respondent No.2, Respondent No.3B and Respondent No.3C, the constituted attorney of the Respondent No.3A and the authorized representative of the Petitioner, are present today.
