1. The present Revision Application deserve a disposal in the wake of the statement made by the learned A.P.P. Mr.Agarkar, on instructions of PI Sanjay Hajare, who make a specific statement that all the documents/evidence that were collected during the course of investigation is filed in the charge-sheet.

Mr.Agarkar would submit that the Applicant has not come with the specific case about which document he intend to

obtain by invoking Section 207 of the Criminal Procedure Code and the guidelines that have been issued by the Hon'ble Apex court in the case of *Criminal Trial Guidelines Regarding Inadequacies And Deficiencies, In Re Vs. State of Andhra Pradesh*¹ and, in particular, guideline No.4.

Reserving the liberty in the Applicant to file an appropriate application, in case if the Applicant becomes aware that some document, though having been collected by the Investigating Officer, has not been compiled in the charge-sheet, to move an appropriate application at that stage, the Revision Application is disposed off.

The Legal Services Authority is directed to pay the legal remuneration due and payable to her, within a period of six weeks from today.
