

4. According to the prosecution, on 16 October 2021, the present applicant and other co-accused committed the murder of the deceased due to previous disputes.

5. According to the prosecution, Shafiq Suleman Inamdar is an eye-witness to the alleged incident.

6. I have perused the statement of said eye-witnesses. He has not attributed any role to the present applicant in the alleged incident. I am therefore inclined to release the applicant on bail. Hence, the following order is passed:

- (i) Application is allowed.
- (ii) The applicant- Bharat Janaku Vayal shall be released on bail in Crime No. 577 of 2021 registered at Manchar Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code on furnishing PR bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one or two sureties in the like amount.
- (iii) The applicant shall not enter into the limits of Taluka Ambegaon till conclusion of trial.

7. Interim Application does not survive and the same is disposed of.
