1. Present Petition is under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for lodgment of crime on the basis of complaint dated 14th June 2018 submitted to Superintendent of Police, Pune (Rural), Pashan, Pune, on which cognizance has not been taken by Police Authorities.

2. It is the settled position of law and as has been reiterated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its decision in the case of *M.Subramaniam & another Vs. S.Janaki & another* reported in (2020)16-SCC-728 that, Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for lodgment of crime is not maintainable.

3. In view thereof, learned Advocate for the Petitioner seeks leave to withdraw present Petition with liberty to file a private complaint if

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so advised and as may be permissible under the provisions of law.
